Fish dinners will be \$12, Shrimp dinners will be \$13, Fish Sandwich is \$8, Mozzarella sticks \$3, Grilled cheese dinner will be \$5. Extra sides are \$2 each. Choices are macaroni and cheese, fries, or cole slaw. All meals include drink and dessert.

CHURCH RULES FOR LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

FASTING – ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY

Must be done by all aged 18-59; only one main meal; two other lesser meals may be consumed which must not equal as much as one main meal; liquids permitted

ABSTINENCE – ASH WEDNESDAY & ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT

Must be done by all who are at least 14 years old; no consumption of flesh meat (beef, pork, chicken, etc.); seafood (fish, shrimp, shellfish, etc.) permitted

These rules presume the good health of the participant. If your health is precarious and will not allow you to engage these practices, put your health first.

These ancient and biblical practices of fasting are meant to help us to re-prioritize and put God, and others, first in our lives, realizing anew our dependence on God and increasing our gratitude for all we have.

May they help us all experience a blessed Lent! - Fr. Lange
