Blessed Solemnity of the Corpus Christi!

In Latin, that means "The Body of Christ". But really we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ today, as made present for us in the Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament.

Today is the day we celebrate the great gift of the doctrine of the Real Presence of our Lord Jesus in the Eucharist! He is present "Body, blood, soul, and divinity" under the appearance of bread and wine.

What a gift this is. Our Lord wanted to be present with us until he comes again in glory. But he knows we are weak and cannot yet handle His full presence. So He gave himself to us in such a non-obtrusive and gentle way: as real food and drink. And yet this is the most intimate and powerful way. As humans, what could be more close to us than what we partake as food and drink? It becomes a very part of every cell of our bodies! And more wondrously, our spirits. That is the wonder of the gift of the Eucharist. We become Christ's body, because, as the old saying goes, "You are what you eat." What an amazing thing! Then, the challenge is to live like it.
