Welcome to **Ordinary Time**! The word "Ordinary" here doesn't mean what we think. In English, the word connotes "boring". But in the Latin root, it means something more like "Foundational". It's true that in Ordinary Time we're not celebrating anything special like Easter or Christmas, or anything extra penitential like Lent or Advent. But it's not that we're celebrating a lack of something special. It's that we're not celebrating any single aspect of our faith. Instead, we're celebrating everything — all aspects of our Faith! Think of Ordinary Time more that way. And the color of Ordinary Time is Green. That's the color of nature in its full bloom. And so it is with Ordinary Time. We celebrate the liturgical year in its full bloom, not in some handicapped way.

As we have concluded our **CCD year**, I want to especially thank our CCD teachers, and particularly our CCD Coordinator Lindsay Rawe! You all are so devoted to passing on the treasures of our faith. You cultivate the students' minds, but even more importantly, their hearts, to love Jesus and his Body the Church and our holy Catholic Faith. Your job is SO important, as you supplement the faith formation parents give to their children in the home. (Remember the primary teachers of the faith are the parents — which many of you do so well too!). But it is important to have a parish religious training component as well. And you all create a wonderful example of that here at St. Matthew! I am always so amazed at the number of young people we have here relative to the size of our parish.
